ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Age Requirement: Applicants must be 18 years or older at the time of enrolment.
- 2. Educational Qualification: Successful completion of Australian Year 12 or an equivalent qualification is required.
- 3. English Proficiency: Applicants must demonstrate English language proficiency with a minimum IELTS overall score of 6 (with no individual band less than 5.5) or an equivalent test result recognised by Riverdale Institute.
- 4. Assessment Process: Candidates must undertake a Language, Literacy, and Numeracy (LLN) test along with a Pre-Training Review (PTR) interview to assess their suitability for the course.
- 5. Digital Literacy: Applicants must have basic digital literacy skills to effectively engage with course materials and online learning platforms.
- 6. Materials & Equipment: Students are required to have access to the necessary materials, resources, and equipment for their studies. It is a mandatory requirement that the student must have their own laptop and bring it to the classes.

HOW TO APPLY?

Familiarise yourself with the courses offered by Riverdale Institute to the international students and utilise the information provided on Riverdale Institute's website and in the International Student Handbook (www.riverdaleinstitute.edu.au) to choose the right course for yourself.

Step 1: Contact Riverdale Institute, if you require further information about the courses and Riverdale Institute's team will be delighted to provide you the information you need and help you make the right decision.

Step 2: Complete the International Student Application Form available on Riverdale's website (www.riverdaleinstitute.edu.au) and submit the completed form along with the documents requested by Riverdale Institute to assess your eligibility for the course.

Step 3: Riverdale Institute team will assess your application and inform you of the outcome.

Step 4: If your application is approved, Riverdale Institute will issue you a Letter of Offer and Student Agreement.

Step 5: Sign and submit the Letter of Offer and Student Agreement to Riverdale Institute.

Step 6: Pay the course fee as outlined in the Student Agreement. Please ensure you keep the copy of the payment receipt for your records.

Step 7: Riverdale Institute will provide you with an electronic Confirmation of Enrolment (eCOE) that you will require to apply for the student visa.

Step 8: Attend orientation at Riverdale Institute.

Step 9: Commence your studies.
